I. Welcome & Introductions

The Scholastic representative will be helping with set up at Ball as librarians and volunteers are new. There will be time for teacher previews and for them to do book wish lists. The PTO will offer lunch cards to volunteers.

Angie reserved GES for Fun Fair on March 24. The reservation fee is being waved. We will pay for the cook and custodian. We will need to confirm the cook's hours with Jim Lovelace. GES Principal will schedule custodians. Chatham Elementary is gifting the bounce houses. Bounce house, face painter and magician will need to be scheduled. The Past President will get the volunteer list and donation request letters to the chair. We will need a meeting after Christmas to work on more details. We will need to avoid nuts and latex in prizes. Stuffed animals were suggested in lieu of food at the cake walk.
